### Information: EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS)

Please remember to apply to the [EU Settlement Scheme \(EUSS\)](#). The application deadline, for those who were living in the UK by the end of the transition period at 23:00 GMT on 31 December 2020, is 30 June 2021. A parent or guardian can apply on behalf of a child and link it to their own application (if applicable), or they can apply in their own right. Applications to the EUSS are free and can be made online on [GOV.UK](#). Successful applicants get either [settled status or pre-settled status](#) ensuring they can continue to live and work in the UK after 30 June 2021, whilst remaining eligible to access the benefits and services they could before the UK left the EU.
