

1. Paint a sunset at the sea.

Make colourful paper boats separately and stick them on the painted sea.



2. Paint the colourful sunset at the sea with a contrasting island and a boat in black colour.

Paint the sea and a sunset first.

When it's dry paint an island, palm tree, boat or a dolphin with black paint.

You can also use black paper and create the cutouts instead of using black paint.



3. Paint the seaside with a light house.



4. Paint the cactuses in cool colours- green and blue.

Paint the background in warm colours- red, orange and yellow.



5. Paint your self portrait.

Draw huge sunglasses separately, cut them and stick them on your self portrait.



## 6. Dream catchers

Paint paper with water colours.

First spread water on paper then add some colours. They will blend in water which will give you a marbling effect.

When paper is dry draw a dreamcatchers using sharpies or felt tips.

Use round objects such as bowls or glasses to draw perfect circles.





7.You can also create paper plate dream catchers.

Cut the inside of the plate.

Paint the brim so its colourful.

Make holes in the brim.

Reeve the string through the holes.

Add hanging strings with beads and feathers.

## 8. Bubble paint flowers.

Mix the paint with water and a drop of washing up liquid in the bowl.

Use a straw and blow up the mixture to create bubbles.

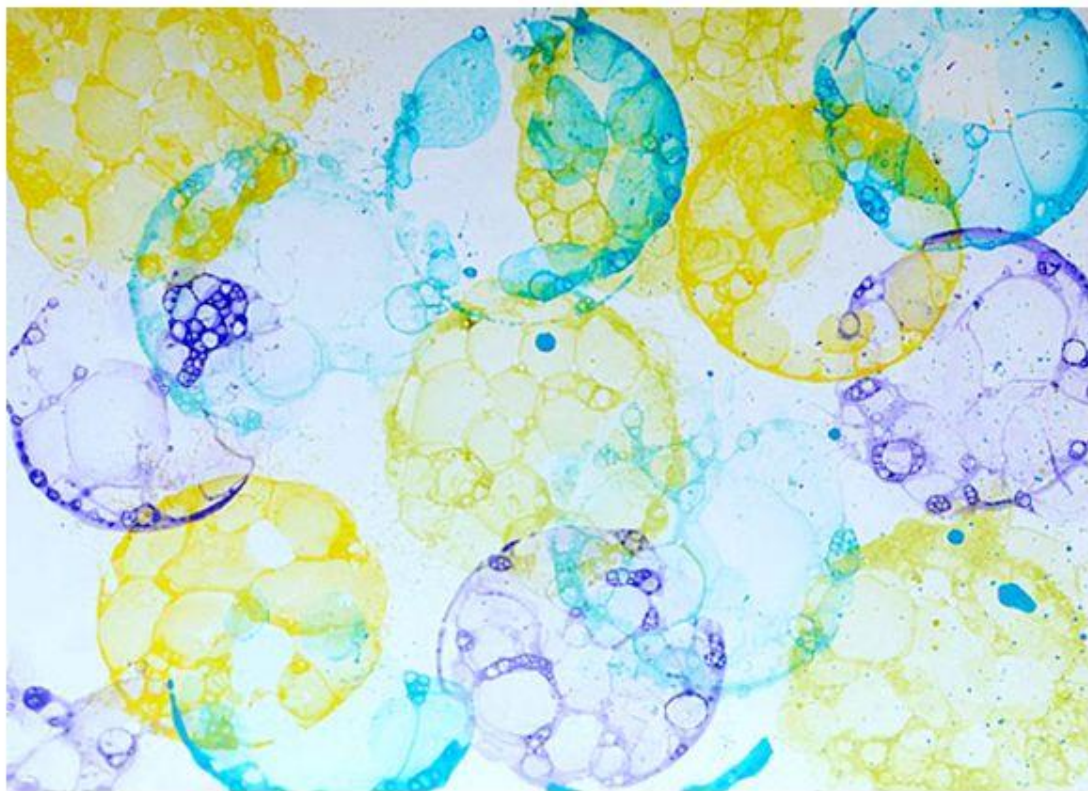
Put paper flat on top of the bubbles and keep it like that for a few seconds.

The coloured bubbles should print on the paper.

When the bubble flowers are dry paint or draw leaves and stems.







## 9. Flower sun catchers.

Pick up some small flowers outside.

Put them inside the thick book and dry them for a few days.

After drying inside the book the flowers will be flat.

If you have a paper plate – cut the inside leaving only the round brim.

If you don't have a paper plate use a card – cut out a round ring.

Colour the ring if you want.

Stick the transparent sticky foil to the paper ring.

Stick your dry flowers on the sticky foil.

Stick the sun catchers on the window!

Enjoy the view!
