### School Coronavirus Guidance

We are continuing to follow local and government guidelines including advanced hygiene, handwashing and cleaning regimes. In order to ensure the safety of our school community, some measures that were in place previously will continue until further notice.

### If your child is ill:

- If your child displays any of the 3 coronavirus symptoms (temperature, persistent cough or change in taste/smell), please contact school and take your child for a test as a matter of urgency. Your child will not be able to return for 10 days following a positive result. Your child, once well, can return if negative.
- Following LA advice, if your child is absent from school with <u>any illness</u>, please arrange for a PCR test to be done before returning to school – some children who test positive for covid have been seen with different symptoms to the ones above including upset stomach, headaches, sore throats or stomach aches.
- If your child becomes unwell during the school day, you will be contacted to make immediate arrangements to collect them and asked to organise a PCR test.
