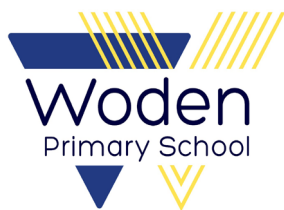

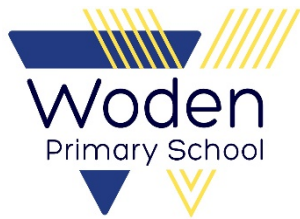

School – Coronavirus Update

We have had a fantastic start back to our new academic year so far. Please be assured that as a school we are continuing to follow all government guidelines, which include advanced hygiene, handwashing and cleaning regimes. In order to support our return to school and ensure the safety of our school community, we will be maintaining some of the measures that were in place previously, including:

- You must drop off your child at the 2nd blue gate and leave immediately to limit time gathered in groups
- It is essential that all pupils attend on time for their drop off & collection. Details of start and end of day times have been posted on Class Dojo and in our welcome letters.
- All children must be accompanied by a parent – do not leave any children unattended until staff arrive from 8.40am
- Please do not leave bikes or scooters at school – if they are brought to school they must be taken home by parent after drop-off

If your child is ill:

- If your child displays any of the 3 coronavirus symptoms (temperature, persistent cough or change in taste/smell), please contact school and take your child for a test as a matter of urgency. Your child will not be able to return for 10 days following a positive result. Your child, once well, can return if negative.
- Following LA advice, if your child is absent from school with any illness, please arrange for a PCR test to be done before returning to school – some children who test positive for covid have been seen with different symptoms to the ones above
- If your child becomes unwell during the school day, you will be contacted to make immediate arrangements to collect them and asked to organise a PCR test.

Home Learning

If your child has to quarantine or self-isolate, please can you contact the school office immediately in order to set up home learning activities. Work will primarily be online and staff will monitor completion. Further details can be found on our school website here:
