We will be maintaining the arrangements that were in place in the Summer term for the first few weeks of the term, including handwashing and staggered starts and ends of the day. We have a number of online learning sites for our children to access at home which staff will provide login details for at the beginning of this term. This will help children to apply Maths and English skills based on their learning during the past weeks. We also expect pupils to read their school book regularly and discuss the story and characters. Learning number bonds and times tables is also essential for their Maths work in school and activities may be set to support this.

Children should arrive from **8.40am** each morning through their assigned entrance and should then go straight into their class after washing their hands. Registration is at **8.50am**. Any late pupils after this time **MUST** follow correct procedures and enter through the school office.

As always, we continue to expect high levels of behaviour and attainment at all times. Class Dojo will be used to reward children for excellent behaviour and effort throughout the year.

In **English** this term we will be using a variety of texts as a basis for writing. Children will be focusing on a variety of genres, including biographies, newspaper reports, letters and non-chronological reports.



Throughout the English units we will be focusing on Spellings, Grammar and Punctuation.

In **Maths** our focus will be on number and place value, the four operations, shape, measure and fractions. Pupils will be focusing on applying their learning to solving reasoning problems, as well as complete a weekly calculations test in preparation for SATs.

The topics this term are:

Science: How can circuits be changed? (Aut 1), How do we classify organisms? (Aut 2)

Art: Containers (Aut 1), People in Action (Aut 2)

Computing: We are app planners

Geography / History: Ancient Greeks

PSHE Being Me in My World (Aut 1), Celebrating Difference (Aut 2)

RE: What can make Wolverhampton a more respectable place?

Music: Happy (Aut 1), Classroom Jazz 2 (Aut 2)

During **D&T** week, children will complete a woodwork topic when they design and create a birdhouse in a group.

PE day for Year 6 is **Thursday**. Both year 6 classes will also go swimming on Wednesdays (class teachers will provide further information closer to the time).

Please ensure your child arrives at school in the **correct PE kit** (White T-shirt, Blue Shorts / jogging trousers and trainers) and a reminder that no jewellery should be worn during PE sessions.
