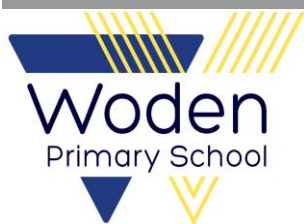

### Before School Club

Before School Club can be booked through Pay360 and runs from 8am. If your child attends, please ensure you escort them to the blue gate and they are received by a member of staff. We have limited spaces for this club so please ensure you have booked your child a space before dropping them off. The cost of this service is £1.50 a session.

### Changes to the End of School Day

Please note the following changes to the end of school times.

**Afternoon Nursery:** 3:15pm **Reception:** 2.45pm **(from main gate)** **Year 1 and Year 2:** 2.55pm; **Year 3 and Year 4:** 3:05pm; **Year 5 and Year 6:** 3.05pm.

Please ensure you are prompt to collect. After-School Club can be booked through Pay360 if needed and runs until 4.30pm. If your child is regularly not collected on time, they may be placed in this club and you will be charged £3.50.

### Flu Vaccination Programme
