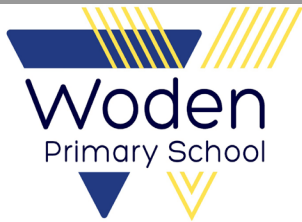

School Uniform / PE kit

Could we remind parents that any hair accessories, head scarves etc. worn in school should please follow the school's uniform policy and be plain in design in blue, black or white.

Some children are still coming to school in incorrect PE kit so we would ask for your support in ensuring that all children wear correct school PE kit of **navy blue or black joggers/shorts and a white t-shirt (either plain or with the Woden logo)** and **blue jumper or cardigan (either plain or with the Woden Logo)**. Correct PE kit fosters a sense of identity and belonging in the same way as our school uniform and it is school's expectation that all children will now wear correct PE kit in all PE lessons.

If you would like to order milk for your child this term (including FSM), please complete the order form using the link on Class Dojo. Please note, unless your child is entitled to free school meals or is in Nursery or Reception, milk should be paid for using Pay360 (£11 for the Summer term).

After school clubs

Letters have been sent home with children giving details of clubs available to their year group after school during the Summer term. Please complete and return request slips as soon as possible. Slips confirming places allocated will be given out to children by Friday 13th May and clubs will start to run from Monday 16th May. Please ensure that children are collected from clubs at 4pm – should you collect late, children may be placed in after-school club and you will be charged.

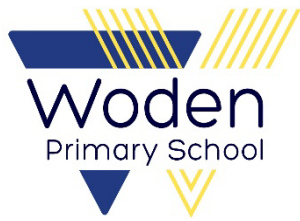
Woden Attendance

Please ensure your child attends school **regularly**, and **on time**, unless ill in order to make good progress both socially and academically. The Government's attendance target is still at least 96%. Please contact our school Attendance Lead (Miss Everett) if you require any further information.

Any absences must be reported to the school office. (Tel: 01902 558880).

It is no longer recommended that children be tested for Covid-19 using LFTs. Children with a high temperature should stay at home for 3 days and avoid contact with other people until they feel well, and no longer have a temperature. In line with school's normal policy, children with diarrhoea or vomiting should not return to school until they have been symptom-free for 48 hours. Any medical / dental appointments must have evidence provided to the office.
