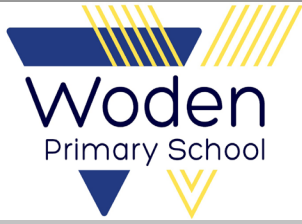

Before & After School Club - Reminder

Before School Club can be booked through Pay360 and runs from **8am**. We have recently had children dropped at the school gates without a place booked and for their safety, we request that parents escort children to the Hub and hand over to supervising staff. Children should never be left at school alone without informing a member of staff first.

After-School Club can be booked through Pay360 if needed and runs until **4.30pm**. If your child is not collected by 3.30pm, and the office have not been informed of a reason, they will be placed in this club and you will be charged £3.50.

If you have not pre-booked, you MUST NOT send your child as spaces are limited.

Comic Relief Day

On Friday 18th March we supported Comic Relief. Children were invited to dress up in something red return for a £1 donation per family. This year the theme is 'Fun and Laughter'. Through your generous donations we were able to raise £151 for this very good cause – thank you all for your support.

School Uniform Donations – still needed please!

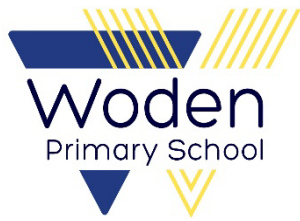
