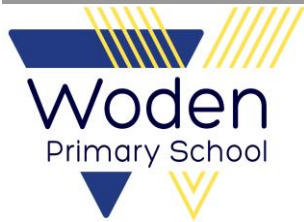

New to Nursery - parent open afternoon

On Monday 20th June, parents of children who will be joining our Nursery in September 2022 are invited to an open afternoon from 12.30-3pm. This will be an opportunity to meet the Nursery staff and see the types of activities your children will be experiencing when they start in the Autumn term.

Woden Sports Day

On Monday 20th June, all parents are invited to watch and cheer their children on at Sports Day. It is the first time that we have been able to hold this event for two years, so it would be lovely to see as many as can make it, to support the children. The field can be accessed through the blue gate around the side of The Hub. Please can we ask that you remain within the area designated for parents for the safety of all children.

The timings are as follows:

Early Years - Nursery am and pm and Reception: 9.00am-10.15am

Key Stage One – Years 1 and 2: 10.30am-11.45am

Key Stage Two – Years 3, 4, 5 and 6: 1.20pm-2.50pm

All children must be in the correct PE Kit: White t-shirt, dark blue shorts/tracksuit bottoms and trainers. Please ensure all children also have a water bottle, sunscreen (if required) and a school appropriate hat in school as the weather is meant to be glorious for us!

School Uniform / PE kit

Could we remind parents that any hair accessories, head scarves etc. worn in school should please follow the school's uniform policy and be plain in design in blue, black or white.

Some children are still coming to school in incorrect PE kit so we would ask for your support in ensuring that all children wear correct school PE kit of **navy blue or black joggers/shorts and a white t-shirt (either plain or with the Woden logo) and blue jumper or cardigan (either plain or with the Woden Logo)**. Correct PE kit fosters a sense of identity and belonging in the same way as our school uniform and it is school's expectation that all children will now wear correct PE kit in all PE lessons.

Woden Attendance

Please ensure your child attends school **regularly**, and **on time**, unless ill in order to make good progress both socially and academically. The Government's attendance target is still at least 96%. Please contact our school Attendance Lead (Miss Everett) if you require any further information.

Any absences must be reported to the school office. (Tel: 01902 558880).

It is no longer recommended that children be tested for Covid-19 using LFTs. Children with a high temperature should stay at home for 3 days and avoid contact with other people until they feel well, and no longer have a temperature. In line with school's normal policy, children with diarrhoea or vomiting should not return to school until they have been symptom-free for 48 hours. Any medical / dental appointments must have evidence provided to the office.
