Reception places for September 2023

Please be aware that you can now apply for your child to join Reception next year if they were born between 1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019. School applications must be made by 15 January 2023. You can apply via The City of Wolverhampton Parents Portal at www.wolverhampton.gov.uk/admissions

School Car Park / Parking

A reminder that the car park is for staff use only and for the safety of our children, parents should not drive onto the school car park when dropping children off at breakfast club or collecting children after school.

Can we also remind you that cars should not be parked on the double yellow lines opposite school or on the zig zag white lines outside school. This is for your children's safety.
