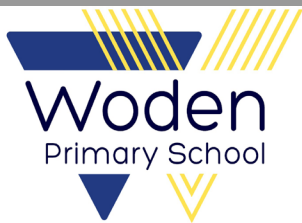

## News and Information

### Before & After School Club

Before School Club can be booked through Pay360 and runs from 8am. We have limited spaces for this club so please ensure you have booked your child a space before dropping them off. The cost of this service is £1.50 a session.

After-School Club can be booked through Pay360 if needed and runs until 4.30pm. If your child is regularly not collected on time, they may be placed in this club and you will be charged £3.50.

### Milk and Dinner Money

Please can all dinner money payments of £11 (or £6 for Flexi) be paid via Pay360 at the beginning of every week.

If you wish your child to have milk this term, please pay £11 for this by **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> January** via Pay360. School does not accept cash payments.
