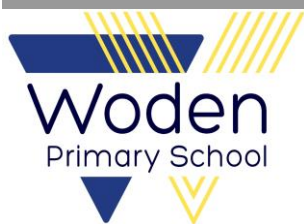

Before & After School Club

Before School Club can be booked through Pay360 and runs from 8am. We have limited spaces for this club so please ensure you have booked your child a space before dropping them off. The cost of this service is £1.50 a session.

After-School Club can be booked through Pay360 if needed and runs until 4.30pm. If your child is regularly not collected on time, they may be placed in this club and you will be charged £3.50.

Parking

Could we remind parents of the parking restrictions immediately outside school. This includes no parking to drop off immediately outside of the school gates. Can we also remind you that parking restrictions are in place to keep adults and children safe when visiting Woden.
