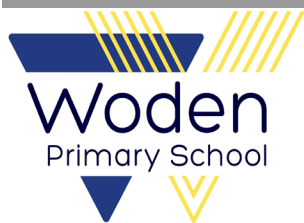

School Office

Pre-Loved Uniform

We would be incredibly grateful if you can donate any uniform items that your child may have grown out of that is in good, clean condition. We have many families that would benefit from this and we can do our bit to save the environment too!

School Uniform / PE kit

Could we remind parents that any hair accessories, head scarves etc. worn in school should please follow the school's uniform policy and be plain in design in blue, black or white.

Children should come to school wearing correct PE kit of **navy blue or black joggers/shorts and a white t-shirt (either plain or with the Woden logo)** and **blue jumper or cardigan (either plain or with the Woden Logo)**. Correct PE kit fosters a sense of identity and belonging in the same way as our school uniform and it is school's expectation that all children will now wear correct PE kit in all PE lessons.

Warm weather

In anticipation of warm weather this term, I would like to remind parents/carers of our sun protection guidance. Ideally, please apply sun cream to your child before they come to school on hot days. The long-lasting protection types are recommended. It is also advisable to provide your child with a sun hat/cap on hot days and we will encourage children to sit in the shade as required at break-times and drink plenty of water. Please make sure any water bottles and hats are labelled.

Woden Attendance

Please ensure your child attends school regularly unless ill. In order for an absence to be authorised, we must have evidence such as an appointment card or medication to support this.

The Government's attendance target is still at least 96%. Please contact our school Attendance Lead if you require any further information.

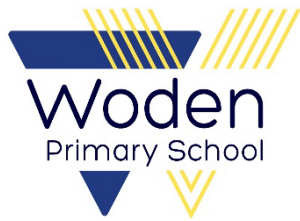
Any absences must be reported to the school office. (Tel: 01902 558880)
