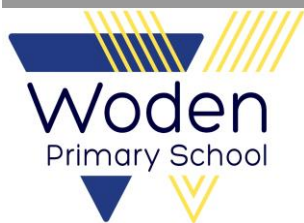

### New to Nursery – Parent’s Open Afternoon

On Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June, parents of children who will be joining our Nursery in September 2022 are invited to an open afternoon from 1-3pm. This will be an opportunity to meet the Nursery staff and see the types of activities your children will be experiencing when they start in the Autumn term.

### Woden Sports Day

On Monday 19th June, all parents are invited to watch and cheer their children on at Sports Day. It would be lovely to see as many as can make it, to support the children. The field can be accessed through the blue gate around the side of The Hub. Please can we ask that you remain within the area designated for parents for the safety of all children.

The timings are as follows:

Early Years - Nursery am and pm and Reception: 9.00am-10.15am

Key Stage One – Years 1 and 2: 10.30am-11.45am

Key Stage Two – Years 3, 4, 5 and 6: 1.20pm-2.50pm

All children must be in the correct PE Kit: White t-shirt, dark blue shorts/tracksuit bottoms and trainers. Please ensure all children also have a water bottle, sunscreen (if required) and a school appropriate hat in school as the weather is meant to be glorious for us!

### End of term closing times

In order to coordinate end of day times with local secondary schools and support parents with collection, we have made the decision **to close at the end of each term at 1.15pm**. Please note that there will be no after school club on these dates, as in previous years.

### School Uniform / PE kit

Could we remind parents that any hair accessories, head scarves etc. worn in school should please follow the school’s uniform policy and be plain in design in blue, black or white.

Children should come to school wearing correct PE kit of **navy blue or black joggers/shorts and a white t-shirt (either plain or with the Woden logo) and blue jumper or cardigan (either plain or with the Woden Logo)**. Correct PE kit fosters a sense of identity and belonging in the same way as our school uniform and it is school’s expectation that all children will now wear correct PE kit in all PE lessons.

### Warm weather

Due to the warm weather this term, I would like to remind parents/carers of our sun protection guidance. Ideally, please apply sun cream to your child before they come to school on hot days. The long-lasting protection types are recommended. It is also advisable to provide your child with a sun hat/cap on hot days and we will encourage children to sit in the shade as required at break-times and drink plenty of water. Please make sure any water bottles and hats are labelled.
