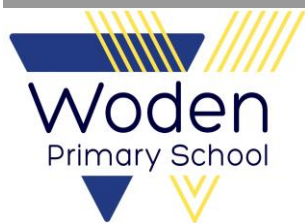

## News and Information

### **New to Nursery - parent open afternoon**

On Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June, parents of children who will be joining our Nursery in September 2024 are invited to an open afternoon. This will be an opportunity to meet the Nursery staff and see the types of activities your children will be experiencing when they start in the Autumn term.

### **Sports Day**

A reminder that all children will be taking part in sports day on **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June**. Timings are as follows:

**EYFS (Nursery am / pm and Reception) : 9am – 10.15am**

**KS1 (Years 1 and 2) : 10.30am – 11.45am**

**KS2 (Years 3,4,5 and 6) 1.20pm – 2.50pm (gates will open at 1.10pm)**

### **Year 1 Phonic Check and Year 4 Multiplication Check**

During June, Year 1 and Year 4 will be completing their Phonics Checks and Multiplication Checks respectively. We are incredibly proud of how hard all of the children have worked to prepare for these.

### **Before school club**

If your child attends before school club could you please ensure that you bring your child to the Hub and sign the attendance register. Could we remind parents that before school club starts at 8am and children should not be left unattended before that time.

### **Sun Safety**

We hope to see the sun a lot more during the next half term and ask that children come to school ready to be sun safe:

- Apply sun cream before coming to school
- Wear a hat (clearly labelled with your child's name)
- Bring a water bottle to school each day.

We do not encourage sunglasses in school for health and safety reasons.

### **Class Dojo**

Please be aware that since teachers are with their classes during the school day, they are not able to read any messages sent between 8.30 and 3.10pm.
