



# Welcome to Year 3

## Our Core Subjects

In **English** this term we will be focusing on a variety of genres, including: Narratives, reports, persuasion, poetry and poetry vocabulary.

Throughout the English units we will be focusing on Spellings, Grammar and Punctuation.

In **Maths**, our focus will be on:

Place value, fractions, measurement (time), statistics, geometry, addition subtraction, multiplication, division, measurement (volume, mass and capacity) and area and volume of shapes.

Throughout our Maths lessons, we will be focusing on Times Tables so we ask that you encourage and support your child with their learning of these at home, please. Pupils will also need to be fluent with corresponding

In **Science Summer 1** our focus will be 'Where Do Light and Shadows Come From?

In **Science Summer 2**, our focus *will on* 'How Are Rocks, Fossils and Soil Formed?'

During these topics we will research, investigate and conclude our findings!

## Our Foundation Subjects

### History and Geography

In History, pupils will learn about how life during Anglo Saxon times.

During Geography pupils will learn all about 'Madagascar'.

### Music

In Music lessons, pupils will learn to sing and perform the song, *Bringing Us Together*. They will learn how to warm up their voices and follow a pulse and a rhythm in time. In the topic, *Reflect Rewind and Replay*, pupils will appraise music, improvise and perform their work.

### Art and DT

In Summer 1 Art lessons, pupils will be looking at Anglo Saxon artefacts and art work.

In Summer 2 Art lessons, pupils will be looking at European art and various artists. . In DT, pupils will design and make their own moving monsters.

### RW

In Summer, pupils will be learning about SIKHS AND HINDUS: WHO IS INSPIRING? Pupils will learn all about inspirational founders and leaders.

### Computing

During Summer term pupils will focus on a number of Computing topics including Simulation, Graphing and Presenting.

### PE

In Summer 1, pupils will complete learn all about Tennis and Netball including both offensive and defensive skills. In Summer 2, pupils will explore Athletics, and cricket, perfecting skills such as batting and fielding.

### PSHE

Pupils will learn about relationships and 'changing me, which will give them the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives.
